

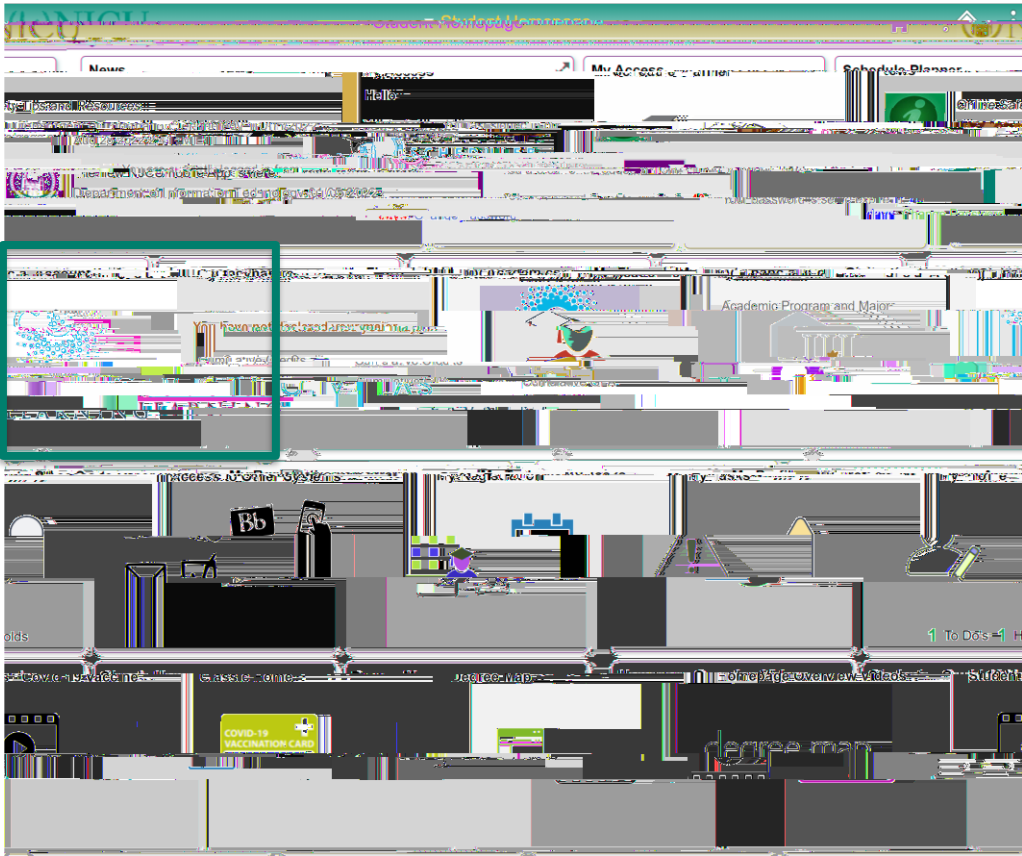

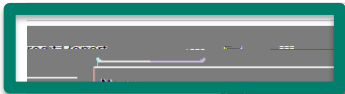

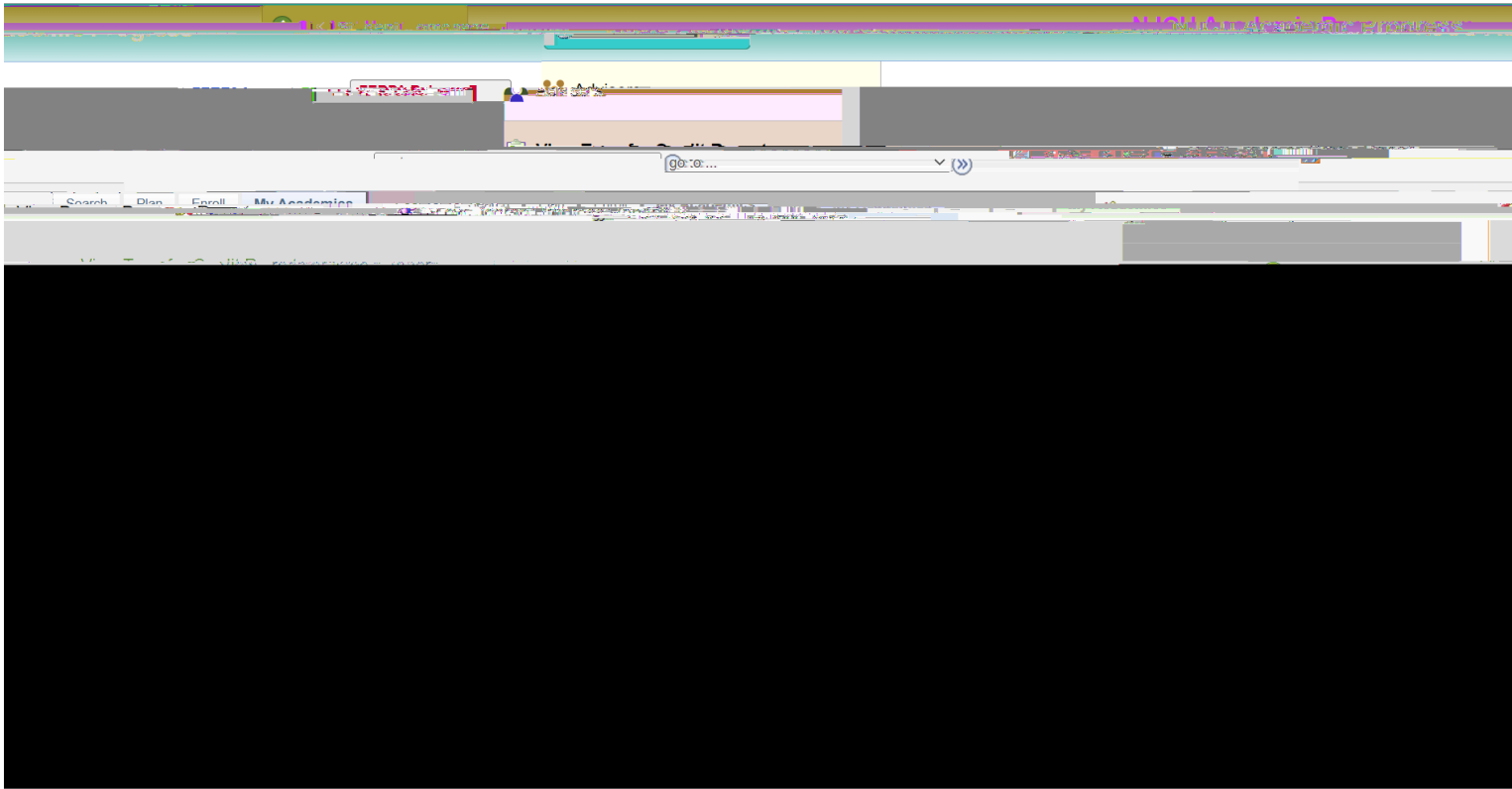

NJC

A course covers the same material and topics as a NJCU course and receives a direct equivalent. (ex. MGMT 235)

This type of credit is awarded when NJCU does not offer a similar course from the same department. (ex. MGMT 2XX)

This type of credit is awarded when a course is transferrable, but NJCU does not have a corresponding department. (ex. TRNS100)

Courses that are vocational, remedial, do not meet minimum grade requirements, from a non-regionally accredited institution, or after review are considered non-
