





Reading Your Credit Evaluation

Types Of Credit

- 1. Direct Equivalent Credit A course covers the same material and topics as a NJCU course and receives a direct equivalent. (ex. MGMT 235)
- 2. Departmental Bective Oredit This type of credit is awarded when NJCU does not offer a similar course from the same department. (ex. MGMT 2XX)
- 3. General Elective Credit This type of credit is awarded when a course is transferrable, but NJCU does not have a corresponding department. (ex. TRNS100)
- 4. No Credit Courses that are vocational, remedial, do not meet minimum grade requirements, from a non-regionally accredited institution, or after review are considered non-
