DOCUMENT CHECKLIST**

To be considered for an EOF undergraduate or graduate grant, applicants must:

1. File the 2023-2024 FAFSA or NJ Alternative Financial Aid Application

2. Submit a completed and signed 2023-2024 Verification Worksheet
3. Submit the following documents (instructions will be sent to eligible applicants).
 - o 2020 & 2021 federal income tax forms **IRS Tax Transcripts**
If your parents filed separately but are still married, the filing status for 20

the Principal Balance

- o **Owed on the house**
 - o A 2020 & 2021 **“Tax Assessment Statement”** (from your local City Hall)
- o Copy of Student’s Social Security Card
- o Proof of nontaxable income (if applicable)
 - o Social Security Benefits (SSDI/SSI) Submit a 1099 Form letter from the Social Security Administration stating the **total dollar amount** received in 2020 & 2021
 - o Welfare Benefits Submit a letter from Welfare Services stating the **total**

(except NJ Alternate Financial Aid applicants)

If you are a citizen of the United States, submit one of the following documents

- o US Birth Certificate
- o US Passport
- o Certificate of Naturalization

If you are an eligible non-citizen, submit one of the following documents:

- o Alien Registration Card (Green Card)
- o I-94 Departure Document
- o Passport with (INS) stamp
- o Asylum/Refugee Document
